

Benefit Area Workforce Development	Description of Benefit Online adds are run on members' behalf for workers. IEC has a full-time worker force recruiter that attends job fairs, attends school functions and works with veteran's administration on IEC member's behalf
Apprenticeship Training Program	DOL certified apprenticeship program meets Davis-Bacon Act requirements. Serving the entire Southeast through physical locations and online live webcast. DOL journeyman card issued upon completion (good in all 50 states)
Advanced Electricians Training	The Professional Electricians Program (PEP) is an online two-year program for journeyman that have the field knowledge, but lack formal training. Topics include: Motor Controls, Code Fundamentals, Theory, Blueprint Reading, Leadership. Meets the Davis-Bacon requirements. Journeyman Card Issued.
Continuing Education	All classes and seminars meet GA Licensing requirements. Most NEC Code classes meet CEU requirements in GA , AL, VA, NC, KY
Loan/Borrow Program	Loan or borrow workers from/to other IEC members locally, state, and nationally
